The workshop

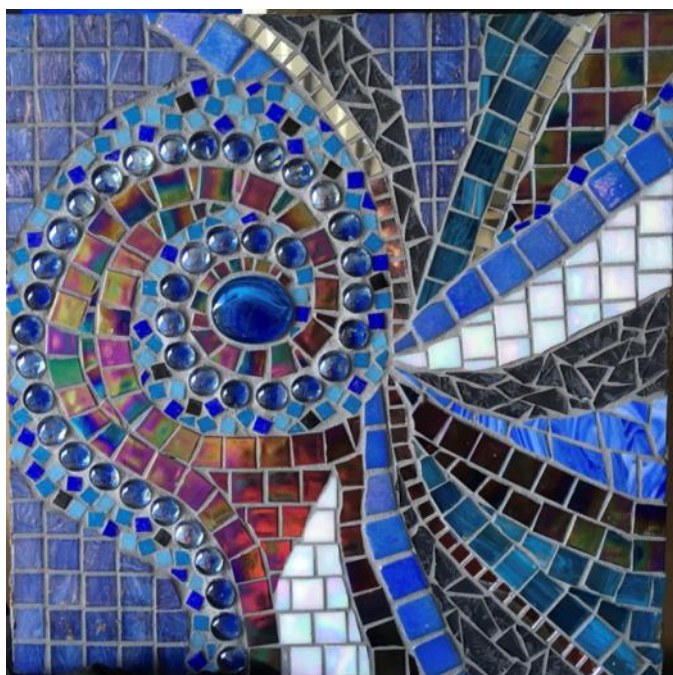

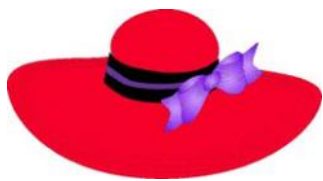


Water Colours at Moore River

NOTES FROM SEABIRD

Thanks to all the volunteers who assisted on June 30th at the Seabird Progress Association's planting day. The slope above the seawall is very steep and the work difficult but volunteers have managed to plant more than 3,000 seedlings. This was a continuation of an existing comprehensive 3-5 year Rehabilitation Management Project, to stabilise the sand and combat erosion above the seawall and to help preserve the natural asset of the Seabird beach and surrounding area. The dune above the seawall is very exposed to salt, wind and spray so the project identified types of flora, quantities required and proposed location, as well as strategies for weed control, and sought to increase public awareness of the importance of their co-operation in supporting the rehabilitation plan. The project has been a huge success. Increasing community engagement in preserving the natural environment and building knowledge and skills in coastal site assessment and planning, rehabilitation, restoration and conservation.

SPA hosted a sausage sizzle followed by cakes and ice creams for the volunteers who were ready for some refreshment after 3 hours of climbing up and down the slopes. Great work with a great outcome!
